

Maths

Measure - Perimeter, area and volume

- Find and draw shapes with the same area or perimeter; Calculate the area of parallelograms, triangles, cubes and cuboids.

Ratio and proportions

- Calculate ratios and use ratios to work out an amount; enlarge shapes by a scale factor.

Geometry - properties of shapes

- Measure angles and draw shape accurately using a protractor; explore properties of polygons & circles

PSCHE

Safe relationships – recognising and managing pressure

- Compare the features of a healthy and unhealthy friendship
- Explain how perceived differences can lead to wrong assumptions and missed opportunities in friendships.
- Investigate how we feel about differences.

Writing

Information text

- Based on the class book, *The Boy at the Back of the Class*, children will write an information text on how to survive primary school. Pupils will be exploring ways of incorporating formal features in their writing.

Recount

- Using Ahmet's experiences, one of the main characters from the same book, pupils will write a recount of events that led him to become a refugee in London.

- Recognise the difference between a series and a parallel circuit.
- Recognise the symbols for various common circuit components.
- Know that the brightness of a bulb or the speed of a motor depends on how much power is supplied to each component through practical experiments.

- Design a car that runs on electricity
- know what key components are used to create a functioning circuit
- use switches and circuits to make a moving vehicle
- evaluate a completed product against the original design sheet.
