READING

NC OBJECTIVES: Read aloud books closely matched to their improving phonic knowledge, sounding out unfamiliar words accurately, automatically and without undue hesitation . Re-read these books to build up their fluency and confidence in word reading.

WRITING

NC OBJECTIVES: To explore the ways authors and illustrators use tools to convey character emotions. To emphasize with a character and make predictions on what has been covered. To relate own experiences with a story they have read.

To plan and execute the planning in writing recounts, letters and descriptive writing. To collate information for a non-chronological report. To include grammatical and lexical features to enhance the text i.e. plurals, apostrophes, contracted words and a variety of punctuation marks

MATHS

NC OBJECTIVES:

Adding fractions with whole numbers and recognising unit and non unit fractions.

Interpret and construct simple pictograms, tally charts, block diagrams and simple tables.

Choose and use appropriate standard units to estimate and measure length/height in any direction (m/cm); mass (kg/g); temperature (°C); capacity (litres/ml) to the nearest appropriate unit, using rulers, scales, thermometers and measuring vessels.
