## Topic Web: Autumn half-term 2, YEAR 1

### READING

We will continue using our reading scheme of work Read, Write Inc. They will learn new sounds, apply them and begin developing fluency.

#### RELEVANT CROSS-CURRICULAR OBJECTIVES:

Children will read our link text and books related to our theme.

### WRITING

To spell words phonetically correct. Able to read and write year 1 common exception words.

#### RELEVANT CROSS-CURRICULAR OBJECTIVES:

Children will explore the concept of individuality and respect for others through our chosen texts.

### MATHS

Children will learn to count on and back from 10, add parts to find the whole, find a missing part, practice using number bonds, find fact families and solve word problems. Children will also learn to use a number line. Children will learn about 2D and 3D shapes.

#### RELEVANT CROSS-CURRICULAR OBJECTIVES:

Children will begin to work as individuals and in pairs. They will recognise their strength and weaknesses they have as individuals in Maths.

### DESIGN & TECHNOLOGY— Food

**Food Unit:** Children will learn about a healthy diet and the Eat Well plate, what a healthy meal consists of, the 5-a-day and how to make a healthy smoothie and fruit salad.

#### RELEVANT CROSS-CURRICULAR OBJECTIVES:

Children will look at how to keep their body healthy in Science and a nonfiction text about growing in English. They will develop their fine motor skills.

**HISTORY:** Children will learn how their life is different from their parents/ grandparents. Children will ask and answer questions relating to the past. They will make comparisons to toys from the past and the toys they currently play with.
