## Topic Web: Spring half-term 2, YEAR 1

### READING

Apply phonic knowledge to decode words.

#### RELEVANT CROSS-CURRICULAR OBJECTIVES:

Children will read our link text and books related to our theme.

### WRITING

To spell words phonetically correct. Able to read and write year 1 common exception words. Children will be exploring Fiction and non fiction text.

#### RELEVANT CROSS-CURRICULAR OBJECTIVES:

Children will explore the concept of individuality and respect for others through our chosen texts.

### MATHS

Children will learn about length and height. They will do some measuring using rulers and solve word problems involving length. Children will then move onto learning about capacity.
