Topic Web: Autumn half-term 2, YEAR 6

READING

NC OBJECTIVES:

Comprehension - checking that the book makes sense to them, discussing their understanding and exploring the meaning of words in context /reading books that are structured in different ways and reading for a range of purposes

RELEVANT CROSS-CURRICULAR OBJECTIVES:

Pupils will be reading the classic novella , 'A Christmas Carol', by Charles Dickens. They will study the themes in the story and look at the reasons that inspired the author to write this story. They will understand the nature of Victorian society and how there was a large group who did not have access to wealth and health facilities. The children will look at the principle of health and relate it to Victorian society.

WRITING

NC OBJECTIVES:

Plan their writing by: identifying the audience for and purpose of the writing, selecting the appropriate form and using other similar writing as models for their own

RELEVANT CROSS-CURRICULAR OBJECTIVES:

Pupils will be reading the classic novella , 'A Christmas Carol', by Charles Dickens. They will use this book as a guiding tool to analyse the authorial technique. Children will be developing their inferencing and summarising skills as well as writing materials for a range of purposes extracted directly from the book.

MATHS

NC OBJECTIVES:

- Add and subtract fractions with different denominators
- Multiply simple fractions
- Divide fractions by whole numbers
- Convert between fractions, decimals and percentages
- Find fractions of and percentages of quantities
- Express missing number problems algebraically
- Use simple formulae
- Collect like terms and multiply brackets

SCIENCE

- Explain that we see things because light travels from light sources to our eyes or from light sources to objects and then to our eyes
- Use the idea that light travels in straight lines to explain why shadows have the same shape as the objects that cast them.

HISTORY

NC OBJECTIVES: A significant turning point in British history; the Victorians and their inventions.
